Financial report/bills: Brandee told the board that the grant money has come in for the Bear Lake SWCD Diversions and Bank Stabilization Project. She reminded the board that they had a bank account from another project that was left open in the hope of changing account names on it. She asked the board what they wanted to do. Chris also said that there is another district that just has one account for all projects going on. There was discussion had between the board members present. Devin made a motion to see if it was possible to change the name on an already existing account (PBJ) and if it is not then to start a new account. Todd 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Mitch Poulsen: Mitch presented the board with a power point presentation on the Bear River Flood Plain Project that was out in Dingle. He talked about was they have learned from doing this project. He showed the board some pictures and explained the objectives for doing the project.

They have the software to do applications but not the software for the payments. She also said that all the crop reporting is done. Larry told the Board the Kathy is the acting CED for the Caribou office also. Kathy said that Caribou is wanting their own CED and have a meeting set up so we shall see. James said that he had called the Extension office and talked to them about the grasshoppers this year to see if they have a program to help. He said that they have the papers to sign-up and then they work with USDA.

ISWCC: Allan talked about how the agency was reorganized as to who they answer to. He told the board the ISWCC is still looking into the Conservation Districts hiring a Conservation Planner and covering 20% with NRCS. Allan then talked about some of the problems that the Georgetown Project had. When the thrust block was put in it didn't stay when the water was put in. The Irrigation district hired Rain for Rent to handle most of the work on the line. Rain for Rent got rained out and then poured the cement another day. When they charged the system, the thrust block blew off. Rain for Rent poured a yard of cement and the thrust block stayed. Allan then told the board that the contractor has been to Geneva, but the project is still not scheduled for a while.

Grant updates

District Manager: Brandee told the board that the fuels Reduction project is going smoothly. She has been out a couple of times and it looks good. She is working on a date closer to when the project is done to have Tyre come and check it out. The thinning of the trees is taking longer than Etcheverry thought. Mark said that he would like to put together a class for the community like the one Tyre did that he attended. Brandee thinks that would count towards her education hours for the grant. They will start to work on that.
