## **Agency Reports:**

**NRCS:** Larry presented us with maps showing the current snow water levels of the state. He also presented that they are now called 1USDA with FSA and on what has happened for the month. See attached paper. If we don't get some more snow, we will be at 30%. Got 11 Applications for the 2018 EQIP year.

Bear Lake County Commission: Rex was unable to make it but had asked that we make sure that we are keeping up on the 2 grants that we are doing with them. Cindy Garner told me that the financial assistance money is already budgeted for the year, so we just need to send an invoice. She suggested going to the meeting in May to ask for financial assistance for next year. Chris and Brandee will go to the county commissioners meeting next month to let them know what has been going on through the last year. It was suggested that maybe we should ask for more assistance this next year and see if we can get it to help with all the projects that we do.

It was asked how land is preserved in the county. The county must get with the landowners and see if they are willing. Pacific Corp. might have some money to help with this too. It was suggested that Matt could come and help us understand how this program should work.

Conservation Basics: Chris presented with the final report for the Stauffer Creek project. There was a 40% match required and we ended up with a 51.5% match. The ECC project was able to count for some of this match. Landowners will get a 75% cost share.

The weather has delayed the progress on the Thomas fork project at Teuschers. Bryce Boehme wants to so a solar water trough if there is money left.

Chris has sent a letter to the three landowners (Kerry Romrell, Bill Robison, and Rhett Phelps) for the grant they are applying for. It has ranked #1 so things are looking very positive.

Bryce Cane needs to be asked about where his cattle are going to be grazing.

James wants to share on the conference: He talked on the GNA (Good Neighbor Authority) that was brought up at the conference. He talked on how the NACD is reporting that there are 73,000 wild horses and a lot of them are being feed but not adopted out. Next Year the Conference is in Post Falls and he would love to see representation from us there. It should be about November 15 and we should plan now because it will cost a little to fly someone there.

Tree Sales: Jennifer talked to Mayor Sharp and yes, he does want to replant trees. We would like to provide them at cost to the city. James made the motion to provide the city with trees this spring at cost. Devin 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion carries.

Talked about the scholarship applications. It was suggested that they be made in a digital format and put on the website. Brandee will need to talk to Shawn Banks about the website.
